

Last week, there were **330 pupils** who had **between 96% - 100% attendance.**


Banyan class had the highest overall attendance last week.


For parent/carers of children aged 0-19 with ASD or related social interaction and communication difficulties, living in West Northamptonshire.


This term we have been further improving behaviour across the school by teaching our new **behaviour habits**.
