## **Residential Visit to Isle of Wight Monday 5th June - Friday 9th June 2023**

The following is intended as a guide to parents in preparing for the visit to the Isle of Wight

### **DEPARTURE**

We need to depart by 7:15 am. Please arrive at school at 6:45 am, as it takes time to load up the coach! Please administer travel sickness tablets for the journey at home. When we have arrived in the Isle of Wight, the school will be contacted and a message will sent by Parentpay to inform you

### **WHAT TO BRING**

- Please send your child to school with a packed lunch (**NO PLASTIC CARTONS OR LUNCH BOXES**, everything must be disposable) for the outward journey.
- A suitcase/holdall in which to carry their clothes etc. Please make sure that your child can carry their own suitcase/holdall. Please label the suitcase/holdall and include a list of items.
- A backpack/drawstring bag to take on the coach in which pens, pencils, paper, books etc. can be carried. This can then be used on day trips. No expensive games please!
- Suitable clothing for the time of year. We have enclosed a suggested clothes/checklist. We recommend that children bring comfortable clothing for day wear and a good pair of shoes/trainers that the children can do a fair bit of walking in.

### **WHAT NOT TO BRING!**

Children must not bring:

- Mobile phones
- Aerosol cans
- Expensive cameras – we do not take any responsibility for damage or loss during the time that they are on the visit. There are no facilities to lock these items away whilst the children are on an activity. Disposable cameras are excellent.
- Expensive or much-cherished jewellery (school rules for jewellery apply – watch and 2 stud earrings only).
- Expensive or favourite clothing or shoes.

## **POCKET MONEY**

Pocket money is the responsibility of the individual child; a maximum of £20 will be allowed for the whole visit. This must be in a named purse or wallet.

## **MEDICINES**

If your child needs travel pills or any medicine whilst we are away, would you please let us have an adequate supply with name clearly marked and full instructions. In the case of travel pills, keep back enough to give before the journey.

A record will be kept of all medicines administered.

**Any changes after the form has been sent into school must be advised in writing.**
